Saturday, September 25, 2021, is our 10th Annual Chris Rose Walk for Autism. We held our first walk in April of 2011, and the event has continued to grow within the autism community. All funds raised from this event stay within the Centre to promote programs and services for individuals with autism (children, youth and adults).

What does the day look like? The Walk starts at the NorKam soccer field, with registration starting at 10:00 AM, and we'll begin warming up at 10:45 AM. All participants will proceed to McArthur Island, then return to the NorKam Soccer field where the North Kamloops Lions Club will have hamburgers and hot dogs available for purchase for a small fee.
